### Introducing Emily Pearse

Emily graduated from Aquinas High School in La Crosse in 2002. She attended UW-Eau Claire and later studied abroad in England at King Alfred's University. She then transferred to UW-La Crosse and completed a Bachelor of Science Degree in 2007 in Theatre and Communication, and a Master of Education Degree in 2011 with a certification to teach Choral and General Music. Emily's performing background makes her well-equipped to produce a musical. She brings tons of experience, both as a performer and as a coach, in dance, theater, and of course, vocally. Most notably, she appeared as Anita in La Crosse Community Theatre's production of "West Side Story," and as Liz in "Chicago."

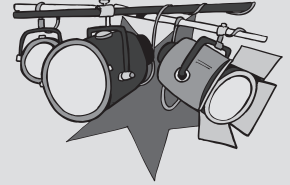

## CAST OF CHARACTERS

All characters are young children who are played by adult or young adult actors. All six lead actors should have ability to sing and move well. (No previous dance experience required!) Other characters will be added to fill out the ensemble. Roles are available for four lead men, two lead women, and up to 20 ensemble members. Adults and young adults of all ages are encouraged to audition!

**Charlie Brown:** (Tenor) A lovable six year old boy dominated by insecurities – also older brother to Sally.

**Lucy Van Pelt:** (Mezzo/Belter) A bossy girl, older sister to Linus.

**Linus Van Pelt:** (Baritone) Lucy's wise but blanket-toting younger brother. Best friend to Charlie Brown.

**Sally Brown:** (Soprano/Belter) Charlie Brown's spunky younger sister.

**Snoopy:** (Tenor) Charlie Brown's lovable dog.

**Schroeder:** (Tenor) Charlie Brown's piano playing friend.

**Other ensemble characters:** Shermey, Violet, Pig-Pen, Freida, Roy, Peppermint Patty, Marcy, Woodstock, Re-Run, the Little Red-Headed Girl.

*You're A Good Man, Charlie Brown* is produced by arrangement with the Tams-Whitmark Publishing Co.

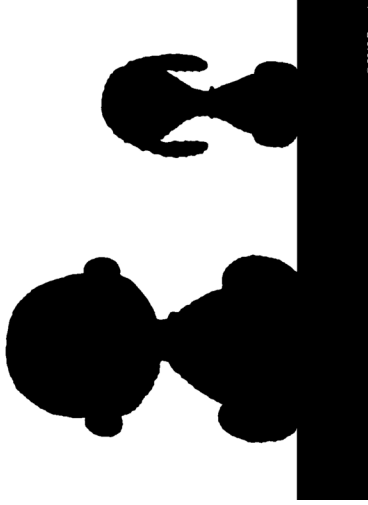
